Tecumseh Community Park Shelter Update

The shelter looks fantastic!! Kiwanis members have spread drywall "mud", sanded and painted the interior of the shelter. Employees of the Tecumseh Township have given all the walls a second coat of paint. They have painted and applied the moldings to the wainscoting. The tiling in the bathrooms will be completed by Monday, Feb. 13th. The epoxy floor process will be applied Feb. 15th. The overflow patio to the west of the shelter, as well as the ramp from the road to the covered patio is framed up, and due to be poured this week. Soon Preferred Lawn Service will begin implementing their plan for landscaping around the shelter.
